She worked as a therapist counseling teenagers with anxiety and depression during her two-year field practice. Previously, Mary was a radio broadcaster for 20 years, working at stations all across the United States and in Europe and South Africa. Mary's commitment to teens was developed from the many years she spent talking to teens on radio stations that mostly targeted young audiences. She devoted much of her radio career to mentoring young people and helping local charities. Mary and her husband, Greg, came to Barcelona for his assignment as the Consul General at the American Consulate. They have lived and worked in Hamburg, Germany; Japan; Oslo, Norway and Cape Town, South Africa.
